ORDINANCE NO. 3033

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FAIRBURY MUNICIPAL CODE § 113.02 ADDING PROVISIONS TO THE DEFINITION OF "PEDDLERS" AND "HAWKERS" FOR PURPOSES OF THE PEDDLERS AND HAWKERS CODE PROVISION.

WHEREAS, Fairbury Municipal Code §§ 113.01 to 113.05 currently governs particular peddlers and vendors within the City of Fairbury by requiring a license approved by the City for particular practices;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to address the matter of long-term garage/yard sales and/or flea markets, and ensure they are governed with a requirement for review and licensing by the City as appropriate;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRBURY, JEFFERSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1: That Fairbury Municipal Code § 113.02 is amended as follows:

PEDDLERS and HAWKERS. Include any person, firm, or corporation vending merchandise and services within the corporate limits who sell directly or indirectly, for present or future delivery, whether sold by sample or by taking orders. Businesses and activities included in this definition shall include, but not be limited to, dealers in home improvements, termite control, tree servicing, insurance solicitation, magazine sales, book sales, novelties, tapestries, fruit and vegetable vendors, flea markets, and garage or yard sales or similar sales events that last longer than 5 days at a time or that occur more frequently than once every 6 months.

Section 2: That all ordinances, resolutions and Code sections or portions thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
