1. Overview of NAHPS

This manual is designed to introduce the Nebraska Animal Permit System (NAHPS) and provide basic information on the NAHPS website located at:

<https://nahps.ne.gov/homepage.aspx>

NAHPS is a web-based system that allows veterinarians to submit and track entry permit applications and print a copy of their entry permit from their computers without needing to call the Nebraska State Veterinarian's office.

Users will be required to register before they are able to fully access the permit system and start issuing your own permits as well as checking Livestock Import Requirements for Nebraska. For Livestock Import Requirements into Nebraska you can also access that information at the following website:

The NAHPS program was developed with a variety of people and entities working diligently over the years to achieve a "useful tool system" that will be able to adapt quickly to animal import issues and import requirement checking from Veterinarian's around the country and to ease the burden of importing livestock into the State of Nebraska. - You will need to enter your first and last name as registered with the USDA “NAN” National Accreditation Number, your 6 digit federal accreditation number “NAN”, a user name and password, email address, postal code and company name. Password must contain a minimum of 8 characters with 1 capital letter, 1 number, and 1 special character (!\$%*)

- If you are an International Veterinarian you will need to contact The Nebraska Department of Agriculture during the business hours of Monday thru Friday 8am to 5pm cst except holidays. That phone number is (402) 471-2351, and we will have one of our office staff team members set your account up for you.

- Once you make that selection you will need to tell us what Identification you have used on your animal's

- Again this field will be species specific based upon your previous selections, that will formulate what type of ID choices you will have to select from.
- After your ID selection you will need to record the CVI or Health Certificate or Reference Sheets that these animals are moving on

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- You will need to use this section to make any additional comments about the permit and movement you are attempting to complete. This is also a useful section to use if you have mixed loads. EX: You are moving Steers and Heifers on the same load notate here how many steers you are moving and how many heifers you are moving to equal the quantity amount you entered above.
- Once you are ready to proceed with the permit you will hit next, the system will check the entered information and potentially populate more questions for you to

answer which will appear in the middle of the screen generally, you will see a red required word and asterisk

The (CVI) shall contain the name and address of both consignor and consignee, the purpose of movement into the state, age, breed, sex, number of animals, the destination in the state, the description of the animals, and the identification and specific disease information for each species as prescribed in 23 NAC 2-005 to 014, below. If a permit for entry is required for movement into the state, the permit number shall be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. Each (CVI) shall be valid for thirty (30) days from date of examination, unless otherwise stated by the Bureau, and no more than one (1) movement into the state. Cattle from Canada must obtain an import permit and record permit number on CVI.

The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall be signed by an accredited veterinarian who acknowledges the apparent absence of any infectious...

- This is what a finished permit will look like with applicable CVI statements or information. You will notice the origin, destination, permit number, signing veterinarian, species, head count, testing information etc.

- When using NAHPS if you are just checking to see import requirements into Nebraska a permit session might not always end in a permit depending on the type of movement you are trying to accomplish. The system will check the information you have entered and could result in a Different conclusion here is a couple examples of those.
