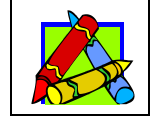




**15th Annual Nebraska Department of Agriculture

CONTEST RULES / INFORMATION**



**Theme:
"Sharing the Story of Nebraska Agriculture"**

Eligibility

- The poster contest is open to all Nebraska students in **first** through **sixth** grades.
- All artwork must be exclusively student created.
- Each submission must be accompanied by a completed entry form (attached on the back).
- All entries become the property of the Nebraska Department of Agriculture *and will not be returned.*

Criteria

- Draw a picture demonstrating the contest theme.
- Each drawing should be in **color**, using a medium of your choice (paint, colored pencil, crayon, etc.).
- Each picture should be drawn on white paper, measuring 8½" x 11".
- **Entries will NOT be accepted if they are folded, rolled up, or are larger than 8½" x 11".**

Deadline

- **March 1, 2018**, is the deadline for entries to be **received** in the Lincoln office. Mail to:
