Dear First through Sixth Grade Parents and Teachers:

As you are probably aware, Nebraska agriculture contributes more than \$24 billion to Nebraska's economy each year. Nebraska is home to 49,969 farms and ranches utilizing 93% (45.5 million acres) of the state's total land area. Nebraska IS Agriculture!

And, because Nebraska IS Agriculture, we plan to celebrate National Ag Week in a special way again this year. We are inviting first through sixth grade teachers and students to get involved in the 12th Annual Nebraska Department of Agriculture – Agriculture Week in Nebraska Poster Contest.

This year's theme is "A Day on the Farm." Students can put into pictures what they feel and think about Nebraska agriculture.
