Plant Health Protection Update

- Free Record Keeping App – UNL Extension’s Pesticide Safety Education Program presents “PeRK” – a free mobile pesticide application recordkeeping app. This app is designed to meet all Nebraska state law requirements for restricted-use pesticides (RUP) recordkeeping and is a handy tool for keeping track of all pesticide use from year to year. PeRK uses a device’s GPS coordinates to note the location of application. Download the app here: bit.ly/UNLPeRK
- New HHW Directory on the Web – NDA has posted the 2013 Household Hazardous Waste Directory for Nebraska, a listing of all known sites where household pesticides are collected.
